PACKING INFO

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Drugs, alcohol, fireworks, inappropriate clothing/swimsuits (see clothing policy below). Do not bring wads of money, expensive jewelry, or bad attitudes.

CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS

If you are going to bring a credit/debit card, please notify your bank about travel days before the trip.

***CLOTHING POLICY**

- Please make sure all attire is modest and appropriate.
- Shorts must have a 3 inch or longer inseam.
- Church clothes: long pants & polo shorts (boys); pants or skirts & modest tops or modest dresses (girls)
- Bikini's, one pieces with cutouts, tankinis that show torso, and speedos are not permitted. Students with inappropriate swimwear will not be allowed to swim.
- Spaghetti straps, crop tops, backless, and low-cut tops are not permitted.
- Undergarments should not be visible
- Clothing with vulgar, suggestive or inappropriate content is not allowed.
- Shirts must be worn at all times, except when at beach or pool.
- No sagging of shorts, pants, or swim trunks.
- All shirts and dresses should have a modest neckline.
- Skirts and dresses should keep you fully covered when bending over.
