



SUNDAY MORNING IN-PERSON INFORMATION

Beginning Sunday, March 7, 2021

We are so excited to announce we are returning to North MB Kids in-person services on Sunday mornings at 11am.

FAMILY RESERVATIONS are required for all who attend on a weekly basis to help plan for adequate materials. Make reservations [online](#) or via the [Mt. Bethel app](#) (download here) and please indicate the total number attending.

NURSERY CHECK IN is required. Our nursery with paid staff is available for children ages 6 weeks through Two's Town 2k (age 3 as of 9/1/2020) while parents are attending Sanctuary Worship Services.

MOBILE CHECK IN for Sunday mornings will be available through the Mt. Bethel app that is ([available for Apple and Android](#)). Use your phone in the church parking lot to check your children in to the Nursery and when you arrive at the nursery entrance, your child's label will be available and your security tag will be on your phone. MB KIDS PROCEDURES

Wellness Policy

In order to protect the health of the children in our care, we ask that children be kept at home with any of the following conditions: vomiting, fever, diarrhea, deep bronchial cough, or any other contagious illnesses. Any child should be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to the Children's Ministry.

New drop-off procedure:

- All families will use the same main entrance at North Campus (entrance/check-in spot prior to Covid- **follow signs**).
- Temperature checks will be taken for each child at drop-off.
- Your family will then go to the gym worship. Kids will be dismissed to their areas after worship **before the message begins**.
- Parents are only permitted in designated drop-off and pick-up areas.
- Pick-up will **be** at the porticos. Your child will be brought to you. **Please have your security tag ready**.

Outside items will be limited:

- Everything must be labeled; we encourage you to write your child's name on diapers, too.
- No outside toys, etc. will be allowed in with your child.

Safety Precautions:

- If a child, staff member, or any of their household family members develops symptoms and/or tests positive for COVID-19, please inform us immediately. In this case, he or she may only return after a 14-day quarantine or when a negative COVID-19 test is presented (this will be determined case-by-case).
- Masks are to be worn at pick-up, drop-off, feeding, and diapering.
- Gloves are worn while diapering and feeding and changed between each child.
- Staff is practicing social distancing from the other adults/staff while providing care.
- Deep cleaning and sanitizing of all toys is completed regularly.
- Sanitation of high touch areas, including pens, light switches, door handles, etc. is performed frequently.
- **Children and students will be socially distanced with designated places.**
